More options for students

Cost effective way of earning credits

More funds for our schools to implement the program

Pathways

A pathway may:

Be organized by a major or career path

Include various core courses required for a degree or professional certification by the college

A pathway does not keep a student from choosing different courses.

Many students will participate.

Many different circumstances.

CCP can satisfy or supplement graduation required courses.

The student has taken all courses your school offers in a particular subject.

The student has taken all the courses they need to graduate and is ready to begin college work.

The student wants to experience what college-level work is like.

Communication and Events

Promote opportunities on websites and in ***all communication sent to students and parents*** related to academics.



Communication and Events

Before March 30

Each high school must annually coordinate with each public and participating private college within a 30-mile radius to ***present a dedicated event*** to students and parents ***prior to March 30.***



Deadline for Students

Public students have until April 1 to notify counselors about participation intent.

Chartered nonpublic and home schooled students have until April 1 to notify ODE about participation intent.

Per state law, districts and nonpublic schools may not establish an earlier date than this.



When high school teacher instructs CCP as adjunct, the college must...

Provide **3-hour** professional development

Observe each course taught by adjunct in 2015-16 and alternating years thereafter.

Colleges Must...

Assign an advisor to each CCP student and schedule student meeting prior to **academic no-fault drop course date**
