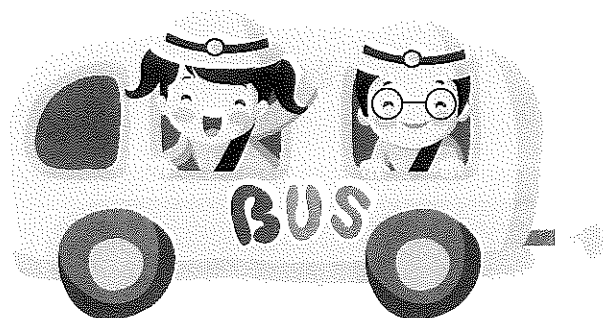


Kindergarten Supplies List

- Bookbag
- 4 Boxes of 24 Crayola Crayons
- One box of 12 plain No. 2 Wooden Pencils SHARPENED (We recommend Ticonderoga brand because they sharpen very quickly and last longer)
- 4 Large glue sticks (NOT BOTTLES)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 boxes of thick Crayola markers
- 3 containers of Clorox clean-up wipes
- Boys - 1 box quart size zip-style storage bags
- Girls - 1 box gallon size zip-style storage bags
- 1 package dry erase markers
- Earbuds or Headphones for Media computer time (whichever works best for your child)
- 5 oz. Dixie cups
- Basic 9"/10" paper plates (no plastic coating)



***Please note that our supply list is very specific. We will be sharing supplies as a class this year. Nothing needs to be labeled except their bookbag. All supplies will be collected and shared throughout the year. We are hoping that this will eliminate some of the lost supplies and students running out of supplies from sharing their own with others. Thank you for your cooperation. This worked really well in the previous years. In the event that we should run short on supplies throughout the year, we may request additional supplies. Thank you for understanding.

FIRST GRADE SUPPLIES LIST

- 3 Boxes of 24 crayons (**please no bigger boxes**)
- 24 Pack of pencils – Ticonderoga preferred
- 10 Glue Sticks
- Small bottle white Elmers Glue (if possible as others always clog)
- 2 durable pocket folders (1 take-home and 1 stay-here)
- 3 pocket folders **WITH PRONGS** (plastic preferred) 1 orange, 1 red, 1 purple
- 1 box of water based markers
- 2 highlighters – 1 pink and 1 yellow
- 2 black low odor Expo dry erase markers
- 2 boxes tissues
- Metal scissors
- Pencil box or bag
- Boys – 1 box of quart size slide-loc storage bags
- Girls – 1 box of gallon size slide-loc storage bags
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 1 pink eraser
- 1 set of headphones to be kept at school for computer use (**no earbuds**)

SECOND GRADE SUPPLIES LIST

The following is a list of supplies that your child will need for the second grade year. These supplies will need to be replenished as the school year progresses. Please write your child's name on each item.

- 1 24-count pkg. of pencils (buy extra to keep replenishing please!) Ticonderoga pencils sharpen the best
- 2 highlighters – 1 yellow, 1 blue
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of markers
- 1 eraser
- 1 large bottle of white glue (no gel or colors please)
- 3 glue sticks
- Scissors (no plastic blades)
- 2 individual pocket folders - no Trappers
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 4 one subject spiral bound notebooks
- 1 ruler that has inches and centimeters
- 4 low odor black Expo dry erase markers
- 1 box gallon size, zipper style storage bags (boys)
- 1 box of quart size, zipper style bags (girls)
- 1 pencil box (please no zippered bags)
- 1 container of Clorox-type disinfecting wipes
- 1 set of headphones (no earbuds)

THIRD GRADE SUPPLIES LIST

The following is a list of supplies that your child will need for the third grade year. If your specific teacher requires your child to have any additional supplies, a list will be sent home the first week of school.

- One box of crayons (24 count or less)
- 24 count pack of Pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga - these sharpen better and will last longer) It is helpful if these are sharpened prior to school starting.
- Markers (a 6 or 8 count)
- 3 red ink pens
- 2 bottles of white school glue (no gel or colored glue)
- 3 pocket folders (Absolutely NO TRAPPERS)
- A zippered pencil case (NO pencil boxes)
- Scissors
- 2 boxes of facial tissues
- 1 eraser (large pink)
- 2 highlighters
- 3 dry erase markers
- 1 box zip-style **quart** storage bags (girls)
- 1 box zip-style **gallon** storage bags (boys)
- 2 containers Clorox-type disinfecting wipes
- 3 spiral bound wide ruled 1 subject notebook
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 set of headphones (no ear buds)

Please reinforce reading, typing skills, and the basic addition/subtraction facts over the summer. This is essential for success in third grade.

Fourth Grade Supplies List

The following is a list of supplies each student will need during the fourth grade year. By knowing these in advance, we hope you will have the opportunity to take advantage of summer sales.

- *4 dry erase markers
- *1 box of crayons
- *2 No. 2 pencils, at all times
- *1 eraser
- *2 red ink BIC pens
- *1 set of markers
- *highlighter
- *white glue
- *2 **LARGE** glue sticks
- *metal scissors
- *white filler paper (wide-ruled) send one and replenish as necessary
- *3 heavy pocket folders (take-home, stay-here and to hold filler paper)
(NO TRAPPER KEEPERS)
- *2 composition notebooks
- *2 boxes of tissues
- *1 container of Clorox wipes (boys)
- *Gallon size Ziploc bags (girls)
- *Headphones (no ear buds)

During the summer, please practice ALL basic addition, subtraction, multiplication and division facts with your child. A fourth grade student MUST have MASTERY of all basic math facts and it will be part of their grade.
